Ages 6-10 (elementary)

This flagship youth program is designed to trade rigid, step-by-step instruction for critical thinking and artistic independence in a fun community environment. Rooted in the TAB philosophy, this club meets weekly over a 6-week course to explore a vibrant, choice-based ecosystem where students are trusted, empowered, and celebrated as they build self-designed projects from the ground up.

Members of the club learn how to think like artists, experiment like scientists, and embrace their creative community.



Studio Skills:

Creative Stamina:

Moving past the "ugly middle phase" of a project to see a multi-week vision through to the end.

Complex Problem-Solving:

Learning to acquire new skills or pivot ideas in response to challenges as they arise.

Artistic Independence:

Learning how to source materials, clean tools, and trust their own aesthetic choices.

Community Building:

Learning how to share space, communicate with respect and curiosity, and celebrate with peers.

For our youth artists (ages 6-11), our mission is to foster independence and confidence by giving them full ownership of their creative journeys. By guiding students as they design and develop self-directed, multi-week projects, we cultivate critical thinking and creative resilience during a pivotal developmental stage. While students entirely direct their own concepts, our expert educators introduce foundational technical skills—such as color theory, value, shading, and 3D construction—through dynamic mini-lessons at the start of each class. Instructors then transition into studio consultants, circulating the room to provide individualized support, help troubleshoot structural challenges, and expand techniques on a student-by-student basis.
